





The Par 3 Advantage

Think your way around the Par 3s

What's your average score on the Par 3s? For most of the golfers we see, improved game management would lower that average.


The target and club selection are critical parts of game management on Par 3s.

This is the safe target area with lots of room for error.

This is not the target area, despite the flag being in this part of the green.

If you're comfortable with the distance to the target, then this is a good safety area.

If you're NOT
comfortable with the
length of the Par 3
you're playing, look for
a safe area short of
the green that leaves
you an easy pitch.





On this hole, if you're going for the target area in the center of the green, take a club which, if you strike it well, will get you to the very back of the green. None of us hit the ball perfectly on most shots. We all usually come up at least a little short.

Jack Nicklaus believed he could improve any golfer's scorecard by more than a few shots if he accompanied them on the round and selected the club and target on every shot. He would play the percentages NOT expecting a perfect shot every time.
