ZWARTKOP COVID-19 RULES & REGULATIONS

Zwartkop Compliance Officers

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The following rules and requirements apply to the Zwartkop Country Club to ensure compliance with the latest COVID 19 related Regulations and Notices published as part of the Disaster Management Act.

T'S & C'S FOR ACCESS AND USE OF ZWARTKOP COUNTRY CLUB DURING COVID 19

By accessing the booking, the member and/ or guest consent to the following:

- No individual displaying COVID-19 symptoms will endeavour to access the site.
- No individual who has tested positive for COVID 19 (and has not yet recovered from such) will endeavour to access the site.
- Face masks / cloth masks are mandatory in all common areas.
- Right of admission is reserved and enforced by Zwartkop Country Club / Zwartkop Golf Estate security personnel and officials. Any individual displaying COVID 19 symptoms or if there is any reason disclosed that place Zwartkop Country Club / Zwartkop Golf Estate, workers, members or guests at risk, such individual (including workers and members) may be requested to leave the premises, irrespective if such individual has paid for sporting activities or not.
- If you have visited Zwartkop Country Club and develop symptoms or are confirmed to have COVID-19, please advise us ASAP so that we can assist in tracking and tracing people you may have been in contact with.

ON ARRIVAL AT THE GATE

- **ALL MEMBERS/ STAFF and VISITORS are asked to USE THE RIGHT HAND LANE FOR ENTRY** i.e. the one closest to the gate house to allow us to do the mandatory temperature checking before entry into the estate.
- If you record a temperature over 38 degrees or show any signs of Covid-19 symptoms, you could be denied access.

GOLF

PLAYING GOLF

- Please don't arrive too early for your golf and be tempted to socialise. Only move to the tee 5 minutes prior to your tee-time and make sure that you are ready to play.
- In line with the regulations, you must wear a mask in all public spaces.

- Please observe all social distancing regulations. Preferably stay 3 - 5m apart at all times – before, during and again after golf. No hugging, kissing or shaking hands and no lingering in groups at the golf shop / tee / practice putting green or outside the clubhouse.
- Please sanitise your hands frequently before, during and after your round and do not share scorecards, towels, range finders etc
- Pin Flags – we recommend that you leave the pin flag in at all times to avoid it becoming a “touch point”. Only you should remove your golf ball out of the cup.
- All bunker rakes have been removed. Bunkers will be raked by the course staff. Please smooth with your foot after use.
- All ball washers have been emptied, so please do not try to make use of them.
- Please do not touch the dustbins or make use of on-course water fountains.
- Halfway House is now a grab & go - please take your food and move on to the next tee to ensure free flow of golfers.
- Please do not share equipment, food and drinks.
- **Please enter your scores using the HNA App / website.** The HNA computer is not in use. If you do not have the App email sharon@zwardkopcc.co.za.

BOOKING AND PAYING FOR YOUR GOLF

- Please use our online booking option wherever possible – visit www.teesheet.co.za / www.zwardkopcountryclub.co.za. Every player’s name should appear on the tee sheet so that they can be traced if required.
- The number of people allowed into the golf shop at any one time is limited. Please exercise social distancing.
- In an attempt to reduce touch points, we welcome credit and debit cards, but we would prefer not to handle cash.

CARTS & CADDIES

- Golf Carts are available on a first come first served basis. Two people may use a golf cart but please wear a mask.
- Golf Carts and pull carts are sanitised before and after every use.
- The use of caddies is your own choice. We recommend that you use a caddie as a bag carrier, spotter and advisor for course management ONLY. Caddie’s should not be allowed to handle your clubs or clean your golf ball.

DRIVING RANGE

- The number of bays is limited to allow for social distancing.
- Range balls are washed after each use and buckets are sanitised before and after use.
- Masks are required in group classes and recommended for private lessons too.

CLUBHOUSE

- The locker room facilities are temporarily closed for use. You may still make use of the toilet facilities but we ask you to refrain from shower and / or changing in the locker rooms at this time.

CATERING / BAR / RESTAURANT

- The halfway house and restaurant is only operational for take-aways / deliveries and “grab-&-go” for golf . No sit-down service is allowed. Please ensure you wear a mask at all times. The bar is closed and sale of alcohol is temporarily banned. We have non-alcoholic options and soft drinks available for you at this time. We trust we can rely on your support during these trying times. You may not bring your own alcohol onto the property.
- For hygiene purposes, Zwartkop Catering has trying to move cashless – please use a credit or debit card when paying for purchases – or make use of the payment portal on our new App – My Home Club.
- Sanitiser is available at all entrances to the restaurant and tables are wiped down prior to and after each sitting.

CONFERENCES / MEETINGS / COROPORATE DAYS / FUNCTIONS

- No Conferences; meetings; functions and corporate golf days can be accommodated at this stage.

GYM

- In line with government regulations the gym is temporarily closed.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Our health and safety requirements still need to be adhered to at all times, such as:

- Ensuring our staff wear fabric masks in public spaces and on public transport.
- Ensuring that if employees are sick or have symptoms associated with Covid-19, they must not come to work
- Screening and testing staff, members and visitors at the main entrance into the estate.
- Maintaining our social distancing principles at all times.
- Providing our staff with ongoing training and guidance on personal hygiene and preventative measures across the facility.
- Ensuring that there are sufficient quantities of hand sanitiser available across the facility and in the offices for staff, members and visitors to use. We encourage you to bring your own for use during your round / gym session – the golf shop and halfway house will also have bottles available for purchase.
- Encouraging you to frequently washing your hands with soap and water.
