Stay dynamic

The correct warm-up stretches before you play won't only improve your mobility and power, but it'll also lower your handicap. But remember, the wrong stretches can be detrimental to your game.



Dynamic (mobile) stretches are a great way to warm up before you start your round or strength session. It'll help reduce your stiffness without compromising your power output. Make sure you're changed and ready to play before you stretch. You should spend at least 15 minutes warming up.

Make sure you're warmed up with dynamic golf-specific stretches before you play a round or hit the range. This is one of the most important steps you can take to a better game.
