


Ready, Set, Go!

Find your feel-good flatstick



Your putter can reward and rescue you, it can give you some of your most memorable moments on a golf course. But you'll need a fitted flatstick that's up to the task.





Finish on a good note

Regardless of what's happened on your way to the green, putting can ensure you walk off the hole with a smile instead of a scowl. But first, we'll need to find the putter that works best for you. One of the most important elements is putter head weighting. Depending on your putting arc, you may benefit from a face-balanced or toe-hang putter. The only way for us to know for sure is with a putting assessment and fitting. Great approaches should be rewarded with more holed putts.

Putting makes up almost half of the total number of shots you play during a round. It's no wonder then that better putting leads to lower scores and an improved playing experience.

Make your own luck

Distances that make the difference

Last week, we spoke about the importance of knowing your best and average distance for every club in your bag. And when it comes to par 3s, there are three more distances to consider if you want to make your own luck and hit more greens.



Once you've noted the danger (bunkers and water), the wind direction and strength, and the elevation to the green, note the following three distances from the tee box:



Distance to the front of the green.



Distance to the pin.



Distance to the back of the green.

A recipe for luck



Know all your distances. Observe course conditions. Practise like you play. Develop a repeatable swing. Check all those boxes and you're effectively making your own luck!
