Suit your speed

Flex refers to the shaft's ability to bend under the force of a golf swing, so a fast-swinging player likely has a radically different ideal shaft flex to a slower-swinging golfer.



A shaft that's too light for your swing speed often results in wildly inconsistent strikes that produce excessive spin-rates. Game a shaft that's too heavy and your launch conditions will be compromised as you'll battle to launch the ball into the air.

Launch monitor data is a great indicator of your ideal shaft flex. For example, if after hitting 10 drives your average clubhead speed is north of 95 mph we may suggest that you're better suited to a stiff-flex driver than a regular shaft.

No standard specs



There's no industry standard for the amount of flex that classifies a shaft as stiff rather than regular, it can differ from one club manufacturer to the next.
