From the Club

As Arnold Palmer once said; "Golfers who complain about the weather or the condition of the golf course, are really missing the point of golf."

There is so much more to golf and a membership of a golf club.

Golf is a social event for 60 million lucky people who play the game around the World. I am talking about real golfers, people who play the game for fun, camaraderie, friendship and sure, a little competition.

But it's the bragging rights at the 19th hole that's more important than the bad lie you got, or the footprint your ball landed in in the bunker. So many of the people I've met over the years have told me that many of their best friends have been made through golf and many of the best times they have had have been on the golf course or sitting around in the clubhouse afterwards with their golfing friends.

Try not to miss the real point of golf – it's not all about the rands and cents.

Your spending account explained

A Full Member, with greenfees included, pays R1380 per month at Zwartkop, and of that, R276 goes into your Club Spending Account.

Considering that the money in your Club Spending Account can be used in the restaurant, halfway house and towards golf shop purchases and golf carts, you are effectively paying R1104 per month towards your golf. If you play 1 round per week, the actual cost of your membership portion is R150 per month.

A 5-day Pensioner who plays golf once a week pays R950 per month, of which R190 goes into their Club Spending Account. That means the actual membership costs R9120 per year, including greenfees. If you put R150 per month towards the actual membership, then each round of golf is effectively costing R140.




